This course explores topics to improve the quality of survey data in Indigenous communities, rethinks validity from an Indigenous cultural lens, highlights the limitations of federal and institutional datasets, promotes methods of Indigenous quantitative data collection in the context of data sovereignty, and applies content more broadly to other marginalized subpopulations.
